
The Volta Basin Authority

The Volta is shared by 6 countries in West Africa. It stretches from north to south over a distance of 1850 km with a basin covering an area of about 400,000 km². Total population about 19 m

Preparatory Activities Towards Establishment of Volta Basin Authority (VBA

- In the last decade, various activities and initiatives have taken place;
- However, current process started with creation of the Volta Basin Technical Committee (VBTC) in July 2004
 - 2 experts from the six riparian countries;
- Mandate of VBTC was among others, identify the issues and obstacles towards the establishment of a Volta basin organization;
- From March to December 2005, 3 Sessions of VBTC were held in Ouagadougou;
- 3rd Session of VBTC followed by 1st meeting of Council of Ministers, December 2005 to sign MoU to create a Volta Basin Authority;
- MoU, among others, proposed the drafting of a Convention and related texts for the VBA;

The 4th Session of the VBTC, Lome, 14 to 15 July 2006, finalized the Convention and Statutes;

The 2nd meeting of the Council of Ministers, Lome, 17 July 2006:

- 1. approved the draft Convention and Statutes; Ouagadougou as HQ
- 2. adopted Road Map priority activities for establishment of VBA
- 3. appointed an Acting Executive Director (Ghana) and Deputy (Togo) charged with implementation of the Road Map.

Within 2 years, July 2004 to July 2006, VBTC changed to VBA

Convention

The Volta Basin Authority (VBA) has a mandate to:

- 1. Promote permanent consultation tools among the parties for the development of the basin;
- 2. Promote the implementation of IWRM and the equitable distribution of the benefits resulting from their various utilizations;
- 3. Authorize the development of infrastructure and projects planned by the stakeholders and which could have substantial impact on the water resources of the basin;
- 4. Develop joint projects and works;
- 5. Contribute to poverty alleviation, the sustainable development of the Parties in the Volta basin, and for better socioeconomic integration in the sub-region.

The permanent administrative organs of the Authority:

- The Assembly of Heads of State and Government;
- The Council of Ministers in charge of Water Resources;
- The Forum of the Parties involved in the Volta basin development;
- The Committee of Experts;
- The Executive Directorate of the Authority.

Statutes (10 specific objectives)

- organize and reinforce consultations among the riparian countries and also between these riparian countries and all the development partners interested in and concerned with the development of natural resources
- harmonize national policies relating to the management of the water resources through the adoption and enforcement of IWRM
- mobilize human, technical, and financial resources necessary for undertaking studies, research activities and works aimed at sustainable management of water resources;
- coordinate studies, research activities and works initiated in the basin for the development of the water resources of the basin;
- create and or improve the tools and networks for the collection, processing, storage and dissemination of data and information;
- develop and implement institutional mechanisms and tools for monitoring, evaluation and planning for an efficient and sustainable management of the water resources;
- promote cooperation between the Authority and other similar regional and international organisations;
- authorize the development of infrastructure and projects planned by the States Parties and which could have substantial impact on the water resources of the basin;
- develop joint projects and works;

Extent of Execution of Road Map

- Parts of the Road Map implemented within the stipulated time frame, while others are still in progress;
- For example, while the Convention has been signed by the Heads of State on 19 Jan 07, the Statues are yet to be signed;
- Also, although the Institutional Framework has been drafted, it has not been approved by the Council of Ministers as the process of its validation has delayed;
- Thus, the VBA is currently awaiting the approval of such key documents as the Organizational Chart, Financial Regulations, Conditions of Service and Cost Sharing Mechanisms.

- to facilitate and move the process forward towards meeting the specific objectives of the VBA, future activities are to be based on the following four elements:
- i. Continuing the establishment of VBA;
- ii. Continuing with priority technical activities;
- iii. Ensuring financial sustainability; and
- iv. Creation of awareness.

- Collecting information on the status of projects and programmes and promoting consultation and information frameworks;
- EU Water Initiative (EUWI);
- Observatory for Water Resources French GEF. Feasibility study and preparation of the project document;
- Volta HYCOS Project African Water Facility
- ECOWAS/WRCU, PAGEV Project Sida/IUCN
- Volta Transboundary Project Global GEF
- GLOWA Volta Project

Financial Sustainability

- Primary support to be provided by the riparian countries through the proposed cost sharing mechanisms. Also, support from:
- i. financial partners
- ii. execution of joint projects, and
- iii. other partnership arrangements, e.g. UN Water Africa
- With respect to the financial partners, Council of Ministers, in a resolution at its 3rd meeting on 17 July 2006, appealed to France, ECOWAS and the African Water Facility to lead the formation of a Financial Support Group for the VBA.
- The first Consultative Meeting of the Financial Partners was held in Ouagadougou on 20 December 2006.
