




Post Forum Activities

New Action of Japan



Announcement at the Forum

- Establishment of "Japan Water Forum" was announced at the Forum;
- JWF will take over the activities of the Secretariat of the 3rd World Water Forum and will act as a connecting point between foreign and domestic water organizations;
- One of the expected activities of the JWF is to facilitate the north-north networking to cooperate in resolving water issues in the developing countries.





Objectives

- Follow-up the commitments made during the 3rd World Water Forum;
- Monitor the actions, projects, initiatives launched in the Forum;
- Identify important topics in the region that should be addressed to the world;
- Maintain and develop the regional network of organizations, governments, NGOs and other stakeholders involved in the water sector in each region.



PWA (Portfolio of Water Actions)

One of the outputs of the Ministerial Conference

- The Ministerial Conference announced the PWA, a compilation of concrete actions submitted voluntarily by governments and international organizations.
- A total 501 actions were presented by 43 countries and 18 international organizations so far.



NARBO (Network of Asian River Basin Organizations)

One of PWA committed by Japan Water Agency and Ministry of Land, Infrastructure and Transport

- JWA establish NARBO in collaboration with ADB (Asian Development Bank)
- First Assembly for establishment of NARBO be planned on 23-24 February in Melang, Indonesia
- Possibility of future cooperation between INBO and NARBO




 1600 rooms within two blocks plus many additional options in the surroundings.
