
# REVIEWS & EVALUATIONS (BACKGROUND & FUTURE)

- **Art. 19.2 WFD:**  
*“The Commission will review this Directive at the latest 19 years after the date of its entry into force [22/12/2019] and will propose any necessary amendments to it”*
- **Fitness Check 2012 (WFD-GWD-EQSD-FD-UWWTD-NitD) → Blueprint**
- **2016: Discussion EC/MS to focus the review (CIS).**
- **Fitness Check 2019 (WFD-GWD-EQSD-FD)**
- **Other reviews: Drinking WD; Bathing WD (Art. 14.3, no later than 2020); MSFD (Art. 23, 15/7/2023)**

Quantification of costs and benefits

Reporting tools (WISE)

Policy coherence (agriculture, energy, transport)

Climate change and water quantity / water quality

Water pricing, and polluter pays principle

Floods Directive - overarching progress indicator

Duration of the RBMPs cycles, and reporting cycles of other related law

Integration of the objectives of protected areas within the RBMPs

Link drivers-pressures-measures

# ABOUT WFD REVIEW

- **Starting point: WFD Fitness Check (available report in 2019).**
- **The reviewed Directive will not be in force before 2021. It will be applied -as early- to the RBMP of the 4<sup>th</sup> cycle (2027-2033).**
- **Objective (according EC): achievement of a simplification, improving of the regulation an its application.**
- **The level of ambition is not under discussion.**

# RELEVANT ISSUES FROM DGA-MITECO POINT OF VIEW

- **Environmental objectives beyond 2027: measures implementation, 4(4) vs 4(5).**
- **Coherence between WFD and Directives 91/271 (UWWTD) and 91/676 (Nitrates D.): state diagnosis, measures, monitoring.**
- **Integration of reporting of water Directives (WFD-UWWTD-Nitrates D.)**
