




ScaldWIN, a project for better water quality



The work packages

- WP1 The improvement of the surface water bodies' ecological status by developing the rivers' ecosystem and increasing biodiversity
- WP2The improvement of the surface water bodies' ecological status through sediment management
- WP3 Sustainable management of the ground water bodies' water resources
- WP4 The evaluation of the implementation of the WFD's programmes of measures
- WP5 Stimulate knowledge and awareness of integrated water management's cross-border aspects

Conclusions economic analysis (1/2)

- Similarities between Parties on costeffectiveness analysis,
- important role of expert judgment
- Response from the environment & accumulated effects of programs of measures at district level difficult to contain



Conclusion economic analysis (2/2)

- Uncertainties regarding: (i) effectiveness of measures, especially concerning river restoration & agro-environmental measures
- To develop the international catalogue of measures



Catalogue of measures (1/5)

- What is it?
 - Database of the Parties' measures
 - Subdivided in sectors, type of measure, compartment and group of substances
 - Economic data (costs, effects)



Catalogue of measures (2/5)

- What is it used for?
 - Synoptic, uniform representation of measures
 - Dynamic database, in which you can correct, add or change parameters
 - Support for mutual comparisons and/or the Parties' approaches of measures



Catalogue of measures (3/5)

Progress 2009

 Evolution from "basket of potential measures" to catalogue of grouped measures

- All Parties have provided all of their measures in different forms
- Not all Parties have approved all their measures on a political level
- At the moment, Parties have little information on the effects of measures

Catalogue of measures (5/5)

- Evolution 2010... (presently being discussed!)
 - Evaluation of present contents and future use
 - Update
 - Purpose
 - ≠ repertoire of all of the Parties' measures and actions
 - ≠ reporting of progress of implementation of measures by the Parties
 - → repertoire of groups of measures & measures having cross-border effects/importance
 - → sets of concrete measures with enough data to make an economic analysis
