



# OUTPUTS

- More than 50 preliminary proposals for solutions
- Issuing a movie about the event which is planned to be disseminated among the participants of WWF6
- Follow up meetings of Youth Water Parliament – activities, meetings, statute, regulations



# SOME OF THE PROPOSALS FOR SOLUTIONS

## *Contribution for the 6<sup>th</sup> WWF*



- creating a “helpdesk” for exchanging practices in implementation of EU Water Directives between “new” member-states and neighboring countries;
- development of a Guidance document on methods, best practices and case studies for river restoration at Balkans level by 2014;
- creation of a webpage devoted to adaptation to climate change to collect ideas and existing experiences;
- initiating of agreements on transboundary basins;
- by 2015 affordable water pricing policy is defined, then ratified by legislative body and implemented by 5 governments in the region;
- in the Balkans and Eastern Europe regions, initiate 4 new agreements on transboundary basins by 2013 and accomplish 2 of them by 2015.
