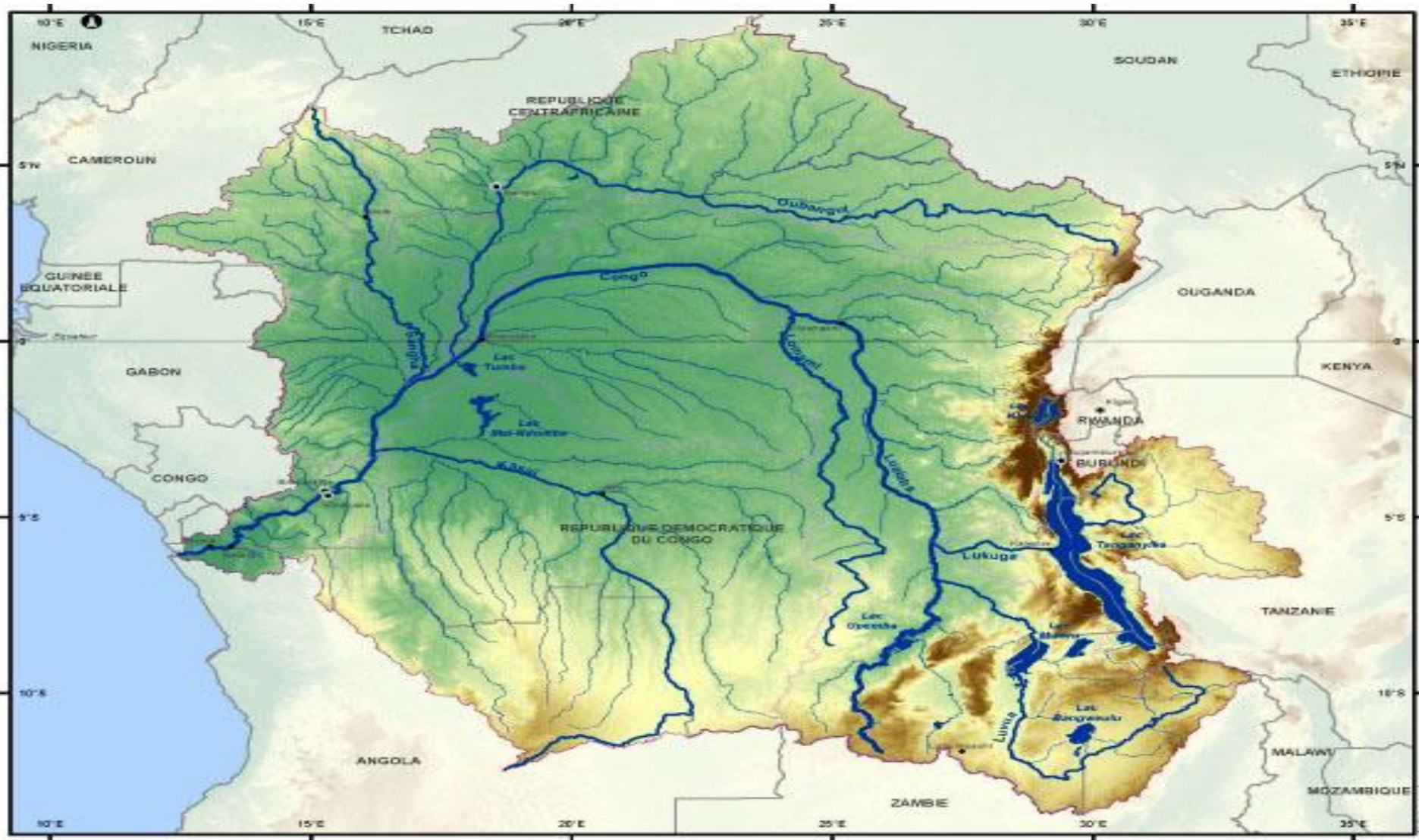

Strategic Action Plan for the promotion of inland navigation (PAS-Navigation);

3-Donor Agency Mapping

- Map out Donor Agencies per criteria and intervention zones and criteria
- **Create Exchange Framework with Donor Agencies**
- **Participate** in Donor Agency Activities
- **Categories of Donor Agency**
 - **Bilateral : AFD, FFEM, GIZ**
 - **Multilateral : UE, UA, BAD**

4-Negotiation Process

- **Identify Donor Agency and Prepare Project Concept**
- **Engage Donor Agency by alligning to their intervention policy**
- **Create Synergy of Action with Donor Agency**
- **Engage and commit Member states**
- **Perseverance, tenacity and engagement !**
