








Objectives 2016 compared to 2009

In a review - take decisions on facts

- "To measure is to know"
 - Reporting
 - Status/risk of water bodies
 - Programmes of measures
- But what about measuring...
 - Implementation in member states
 - Legal
 - Organization
 - Political
 - Strategic
- Be sure to find the root causes





Concerns in the South Baltic district

- WFD agriculture, hydropower plants-cultural herritage (known problems)
- WFD draughts, micro plastic, more to come... (new problems)
- Scarcity of resourses (finance, capacity)
 - Prioritations –protected areas, substances, drinking water, public access?
- Peer review, benchmarking and working groups
 - Legal, organization, political, strategic, financial issues
