

### **INBO OBJECTIVES**

- to develop relations between organizations interested in comprehensive water resource management at basin level, and favor exchanges of experiences and expertise among them,
- to promote the principles and means of sound water management in cooperation programs to reach sustainable development,
- to facilitate the implementation of tools suitable for institutional and financial management, programming, organization of data banks, and for models adapted to the needs,
- to promote information and training programs for the different stakeholders involved in water management as well as for the executives and staff of the member basin organizations,
- to evaluate ongoing actions and disseminate their results.

the work of the « EURO INBO » Group just aims at strengthening the common strategy for the implementation of the Water Framework Directive (WFD), as formulated during the meetings of the Water Directors of the European Union. This strategy allowed the production of many very interesting orientation documents for a common understanding of the various aspects of the WFD, which were also tested in about fifteen pilot basins distributed on the whole territory of the European Union.

The « EUROPE INBO » meeting of Krakow aims to enrich and broaden the experience of the pilot basins by also presenting approaches and mentioning the very pragmatic questions which arise in other European Districts. In these Districts, studies and work were already developed, and it may be interesting for them to exchange on difficulties encountered, results or very operational and concrete experiences accumulated in the field.

It appears that there is a need/place also for these kind of <u>informal</u> exchanges, in addition to the <u>official</u> European platform still very well organized by the EU water directors and the EC.

The aim of INBO is only to enable the volunteer Basin Organizations to meet in order to exchange more on their practical experiences, as the implementation of the WFD is a key issue for all our members.

The result will <u>not</u> be dividing up resources in parallel structures ( surely it's not the intention!), <u>but enriching the process in the field</u> <u>by direct contacts</u> <u>between the public bodies in charge</u> <u>which would be or are yet interested in our group,</u> <u>created on a voluntary basis and free involvement</u>.

> A great number of them coming also from eastern Europe, NIS or Mediterranean countries.
